The IHS monogram is an abbreviation or shortening of Jesus' name in Greek to the first three letters. Thus IHΣΟΥΣ, ἰησους (iēsus, "Jesus"), is shortened to IHΣ (iota-eta-sigma), sometimes transliterated into Latin or English characters as IHS or IHC.
