The toughness, strength, and translucence of porcelain, relative to other types of pottery, arises mainly from vitrification and the formation of the mineral mullite within the body at these high ...

Porcelain. Porcelain was first made in China during the Tang dynasty (618-907 ce).The kind most familiar in the West was not manufactured until the Yuan dynasty (1279-1368 ce).It was made from kaolin (white china clay) and petuntse (a feldspathic rock also called china stone), the latter being ground to powder and mixed with the clay.
